# MINI BAKERY

**Finished Quilt Size 20" x 20"**

**Finished Block Size 6" x 6"**

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website [www.pennyrosefabrics.com](http://www.pennyrosefabrics.com) for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

¼ yard (25 cm) cream background (C4353 Cream)

⅛ yard (15 cm) green dots (C4355 Green)

¼ yard (25 cm) pink dots (C4355 Pink)

⅛ yard (15 cm) red dots (C4355 Red)

⅛ yard (15 cm) blue gingham (C4356 Blue)

⅛ yard (15 cm) pink gingham (C4356 Pink)

⅛ yard (15 cm) yellow gingham (C4356 Yellow)

Binding ¼ yard (25 cm)

Backing ¾ yards (70 cm)

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border and sashing pieces.

### Cream Background

Cut 1 strip 6½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 4 squares 6½" x 6½".

### Green Dots

Cut 1 strip 2½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 10 squares 2½" x 2½".

### Pink Dots

Cut 1 strip 2½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 10 squares 2½" x 2½".

Cut 2 strips 1½" x WOF for Border 1.

### Red Dots

Cut 1 strip 2½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 5 squares 2½" x 2½".

### Blue Gingham

Cut 1 strip 2½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 8 squares 2½" x 2½".

### Pink Gingham

Cut 1 strip 2½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 4 squares 2½" x 2½".

### Yellow Gingham

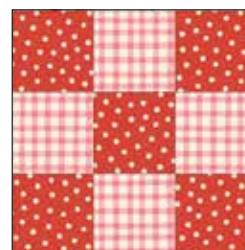
Cut 1 strip 2½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 8 squares 2½" x 2½".

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics.

### Nine-Patch Block

Sew 5 pink dots 2½" x 2½" squares and 4 yellow gingham 2½" x 2½" squares together to create a Nine-Patch Block. Repeat to create a second pink and yellow Nine-Patch Block. Sew 5 green dots 2½" x 2½" squares and 4 blue gingham 2½" x 2½" squares together to create a Nine-Patch Block. Repeat to create a second green and blue Nine-Patch Block. Sew 5 red dots 2½" x 2½" squares and 4 pink gingham 2½" x 2½" squares together to create a Nine-Patch Block.

### Quilt Center Assembly

Referring to the quilt photo for placement, sew the 5 Nine-Patch Units and the 4 cream background 6½" x 6½" squares together to complete the center of the quilt.

### Border

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

### Border 1

Side borders should be 18½". Top and bottom borders should be 20½".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Penny Rose fabric from the Paper Dolls Bakery Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
